愛沙尼亞考察團的得著

猶記得從前有一套劇集叫《尋找他鄉的故事》，講述了海外華人的生活點滴。而在剛過去的4月底，我有幸與一群直資學校的校長朋友，前往愛沙尼亞進行教育考察，以了解「他鄉」的教育情況。

愛沙尼亞是波羅的海國家之一，在二戰期間曾被蘇聯佔領，後於90年代成功獨立。由於他們視教育為國家復興的首要任務，所以近年來推行多項教育改革，同時積極

發展科研，令他們在2022年PISA的評分中（註一），在閱讀、數學、科學領域都位列歐洲之首。它的成功無疑值得借鏡，而這也是我們前往考察的主要原因。

是次探訪的七所學校位於首都塔林及塔圖這兩座城市。我發現當地政府不但重視教育，而且給予學校頗大的自主權。政府以一系列政策吸引從事教育工作的專才，又規定中學老師必須持有碩士學位，以提高



全國師資和教育素質；實行義務教育制度，確保所有孩子都能接受良好的教育；在學校內免費提供書簿、食物、校服等必需品；制訂針對弱勢群體的措施，確保教育資源的公平分配；甚至連國內的一些新聞頻道，也會報導與科研比賽相關的資訊，可見全國上下對普及教育的重視。

愛沙尼亞的學校在課程規劃上擁有一彈性，讓老師可以因材施教。


第二天升中諮詢日負責攤位的家長義工及家委。
